



IU Jacobs School of Music announces memorial event honoring cellist Janos Starker

The Indiana University Jacobs School of Music announced today that it will host a concert in honor of the life of Distinguished Professor Janos Starker at 4 p.m. on Sunday, Sept. 22, in Bloomington's Musical Arts Center. The event will include performances by some of the Grammy Award-winning cellist's most esteemed colleagues and students.

Starker died in Bloomington, Ind., on April 28, 2013, at the age of 88.
